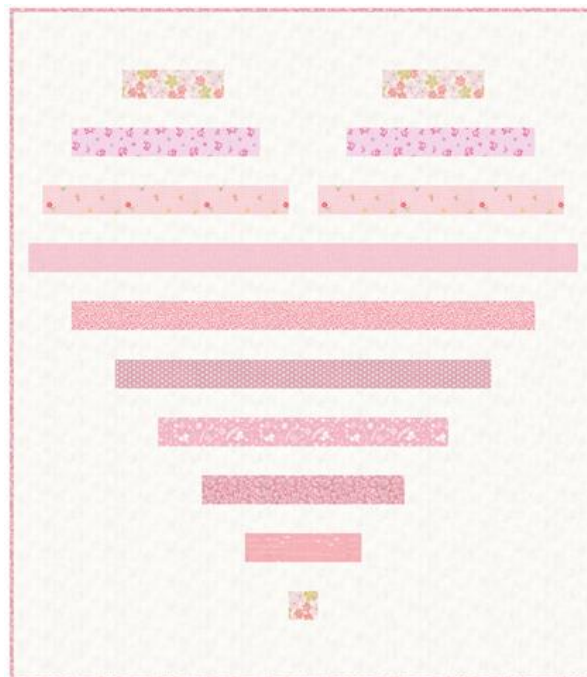


HEART

SCQG 2019/2020 Babies at Risk Pattern

- 1 ⅜ yd Background Fabric: White/Off White/Low Volume
- (9) jelly roll strips or ⅔ yd total yardage of Contrast fabrics
- (5) 2 ½ inch strips x WOF for Binding
(*14 jelly roll strips or 1 yd total for **contrast and binding**)

- All fabric strips are 2 ½ inch wide
- Cut fabric strips as shown in Table A (Contrast) and Table B (Background)
- Layout fabric pieces as shown in diagram (NOTE: Layout shows **CUT size** not finished size. All rows will *finish* at 2 inches wide.)
- Sew background/contrast pieces together into rows following diagram
- Sew rows together following diagram
- Layer top with batting and backing, baste, and quilt
- Sew binding strips together, fold in half and press
- Attach binding to quilt and add SCQG Label
