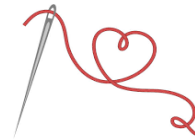




SCQG Sit and Sew and Learn



Sit and Sew is held at Ebenezer Church from 9 to 1 pm on the days the guild has afternoon meetings. The Sit and Sew began and continues to be an opportunity for members who want to get together to stitch and visit casually. Some have brought their machines and many have brought handwork.

The SCQG is going to try something new in 2023 with 3 of our Sit and Sew dates and times and hope you will visit some of these opportunities to learn or come to stitch and visit. Sit and Sew is free to attend,

Ever wonder how to sew an unfamiliar technique? Some of our SCQG members are offering an opportunity to brush up on your skills and perhaps learn some shortcuts. These are short 2 hour classes from 10 am until noon with the opportunity to sew during and after the lesson, go to lunch or stick around to socialize before the guild meetings begin at 1 pm.

Anyone is also welcome to come and sew or knit on their own on these dates but the class limit is 12. Lessons are also free.

Email each instructor if you are planning to attend so the instructor can be prepared with space, cords and handouts.



Basic items to bring to a lesson: sewing machine (you can share with a friend), fabric (amount needed will be listed for each lesson) cutting tools (cutting mat and rotary cutter and ruler), scissors, pins, thread and a fabric marking device. An iron and ironing board will be available. Additional items needed are listed with each lesson.

Sit and Sew and Learn **Log Cabin *from 10-Noon*** with Terri Koch at Ebenezer Church.

The Log Cabin block will require in addition to the above items: a 1/4" presser foot, 6"x6" ruler and even number of 2.5" strips of fabric (lights and darks), 3" square for the center (traditionally the center is red symbolizing the hearth in a home), neutral thread color and a stiletto (optional). Fabric choices can be scrappy as shown on the left or graduated as shown on the right.



This block will finish at 14.5" x 14.5". Make many of these blocks and assembly instructions will follow soon. 9 of these blocks will make a beautiful 42" x 42" wheelchair lap quilt. Contact Terri at tkquilter4444@gmail.com

This 12.5" x 12.5" block will require Two Fat Quarters OR two large scraps of fabric. Add more colors if you choose and a background color choice, and a 1/4" presser foot.

Sit and Sew and Learn a simple **Paper Piecing Heart** block ***from 10-Noon*** with Kathy Wiesman at Ebenezer Church

Paper Piecing Heart block will require: ruler with 1/4" marking, a seam roller (optional since an iron will be available), an open-toe presser foot, white or off white fabric scraps, fuchsia or red fabric scraps or colors of your choice (one piece should be at least 5" x 8").

This block will finish at 8" x 8".
