

Scrappy Charm Baby Quilt 2020/2021 SCQG Babies-at-Risk



Scrappy Charm Baby Quilt - Approximate Size 39" x 45"

Supplies needed:

- 42 5"x 5" charms (Make 6 rows of 7)
- \*\*\*5 2 ½" x WOF "row separators" (need about 33" long)
- \*\*\*4 1 ½" x WOF "Inner Border" (add sides before top and bottom)
- 4 3 ½" x WOF "Outer Border" (add sides before top and bottom)
- \*\*\*5 2 ½" x WOF "Binding"
- \*\*\* CAN BE SAME FABRIC

**Your Scraps PLUS 1 ½ yard backing ..... 2020/2021 SCQG Babies at Risk**  
(Final Size about 30"x30")

- 1) Make a 20"x20" **SCRAPPY SECTION** out of your cute scraps. (you may want to border this section with a skinny strip of a bright fabric)
- 2) Starting with 1 ½ yards x WOF of "BACKING FLANNEL" - cut 3 strips - -- 5"x WOF
- 3) Cut one of these strips in half - so you have 2 pieces - 5"x 20".  
Attach to top and bottom of your **SCRAPPY SECTION**
- 4) Use remaining 5" strips for side borders.
- 5) Quilt onto remaining backing piece.
- 6) Add binding.
